**PROPOSITION NO. 1
GREATER CLARK PARKS DISTRICT**

Board of Clark County Commissioner Resolution No. 2004-10-02 proposes creation of a Metropolitan Park District pursuant to RCW 35.61 with boundaries defined as the Vancouver unincorporated urban growth area. Although there is sufficient publicly owned land within the District to develop 35 new parks and up to 8 miles of trails, the county's policy is that new parks and trails should not be developed unless funds are available for maintenance. It is the intent of the Board that the District, if formed, levy a general tax up to twenty-seven cents per thousand dollars of assessed valuation to allow for such park and trail development by providing maintenance funding.

HOCKINSON SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 98
SCHOOL PROGRAM LEVY**

The Board of Hockinson School District No. 98 adopted Resolution No. 04-05-03, concerning a proposition to levy property taxes. For the purpose of replacing an expiring levy for educational General Fund maintenance and operation expenses, the proposition would authorize the following excess taxes be levied on all taxable property within the district:
