

Notice of General and Special Election

Clark County, Washington

Tuesday, November 4, 2014

On Tuesday, the 4th day of November, 2014, in Clark County, State of Washington, a General and Special Election will be held for the purpose of electing federal, state, county, district, and judicial officers and submitting to the voters for their approval and adoption or rejection state initiative measures and advisory votes, a county proposition and an advisory vote, and local district propositions. This General and Special election will be conducted by mail.

Voter registration deadlines

The deadline for initial mail-in or online registrations and transfers or updates to an existing registration is 5 p.m., Monday, October 6, 2014.

If you are **not** registered in Washington State by October 6, you may still register, but you must do so **in person** at the Elections Department by 5 p.m., Monday, October 27.

The election will be conducted by mail. No polling places will be open. All voters are mailed a ballot approximately 20 days before the election. If you do not receive your ballot, please contact the Elections Department to obtain one.

Any person needing assistance to register or vote can contact the Elections Department. Forms and information are available in alternative formats. Special accessible voting equipment is available beginning October 15, 2014.
