On Tuesday, February 10, 2015, in Clark County, State of Washington, a special election will be held for the purpose of submitting to the voters for their approval and adoption or rejection, local measures for Hockinson School District No. 98 and Washougal School District No. 112-6, as listed below.

#### **Voter registration deadlines**
