

Farmland preservation is topic of open house Nov. 5

Clark County is currently working to develop a farmland preservation program in cooperation with the Washington State Conservation Commission.

A local advisory committee has drafted 24 strategies intended to protect commercial and non-commercial agriculture.

The strategies are now available for public review and comment through Monday, Nov. 17.
