Jennifer Halleck motioned to approve the meeting notes from January 24<sup>th</sup>. Margaret seconded and they were unanimously approved.

### **New Business:**

- a. Goal setting: Group went through a goal setting exercise and chose the top five priorities. They agreed the topics could be discussed as the issues arise.
- b. City of Vancouver Recognition of the CCBPAC:  
Eric suggested forming a sub-committee and motioned to approve starting one. Chuck seconded. Majority were in favor. Ken recommended the group go to the Vancouver meeting. Eric will investigate and report back at the April meeting.
- c. Strengthening BPAC's role:  
Madeleine mentioned the recent study of county committees, or advisory councils. The group discussed how they can promote their visibility and effectiveness. Madeleine will put some thought into this for future discussion.

- a. BRT update:  
Public Hearing – Laurie will email link to the group.
- b. CRC update:  
Jennifer said 30% plans are available for review. An issue is the bike crossing on McLoughlin. There is a quick turn-around for review so no time to share with group.

### **Public Comment:**

- Jim O'Horo said he went to the Parks department regarding bollards on black asphalt. They got the message. He also brought up issues with Burnt Bridge Creek trail.
- Joe wants to know about hearings. Laurie will send out an email about road standards.

**Announcements:**

- Phil said the I-205 bridge is getting dirtier. There's a problem with the design of the bike path so maintenance trucks can't drive on it to clean anymore. It won't support the weight.
- Eric said to keep Vancouver's Bronze rating from the American League of Bicyclists, the city has to apply every year. He thanked Jennifer Campos for applying.
- This group meets on the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month. The next meeting is March 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Madeleine: lower speed limits locally; make local bike and pedestrian planning easier, safe and flexible design.
- Ellen said there is vegetation covering way-finding signs. Laurie asked Ellen to email her with the locations.

Phil made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Margaret. The meeting adjourned at 7:45 PM.
