



INTERDEPARTMENTAL AGREEMENT

Between

Clark County Community Planning

And

Clark County Public Works

And

Clark County Public Health

The agreement entered into this 28th Day of February, 2014 between CLARK COUNTY COMMUNITY PLANNING, hereinafter referred to as "COMMUNITY PLANNING", and CLARK COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS, hereinafter referred to as "PUBLIC WORKS" and CLARK COUNTY PUBLIC HEALTH, hereinafter referred to as "PUBLIC HEALTH."

WHEREAS, the staff with Public Works, Public Health, and Community Planning revised the sidewalk project criteria for the County Sidewalk program; AND

WHEREAS, the Clark Communities Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee reviewed and approved the revised sidewalk project criteria for the sidewalk program; AND

WHEREAS, the staff from Public Works will notify both Community Planning Staff and Public Health staff regarding any necessary changes to the sidewalk project criteria for the sidewalk program; AND

WHEREAS, all future reviews and changes to the sidewalk project criteria will involve the review and comment by the Clark Communities Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee; AND

NOW THEREFORE

COMMUNITY PLANNING, PUBLIC WORKS AND PUBLIC HEALTH MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF COMMUNITY PLANNING:

Community Planning has primary responsibility for Coordinating with Public Works regarding any changes to the sidewalk criteria to ensure consistency with the County Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan. To this end they will:

- a. Meet regularly with Clark Community Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory group and update them on sidewalk and bicycle projects;
- b. Meet regularly with both Public Works and Public Health staff
- c. Take any proposed changes to the sidewalk project criteria to the Clark Communities Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee;

2. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PUBLIC WORKS :

Public Works staff has the responsibility to contact Community Planning staff on any proposed changes to the sidewalk project review criteria. To this end, Public Works will:

- a. Meet regularly with Community Planning staff to update the progress of the sidewalk program.
- b. Meet with Community Planning and Public Health staff, as needed, to revise sidewalk project criteria.
- c. Meet with the Clark Communities Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee on changes to the sidewalk project criteria.
- d. Consult the Clark Communities Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee regarding changes to the sidewalk criteria.
- e. Place information regarding changes to the sidewalk criteria or modifications on the sidewalk page on the County Public Works website.

3. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PUBLIC HEALTH:

Public Health has primary responsibility for coordinating with Public Works regarding any changes to the sidewalk criteria to ensure consistency with the County Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan.

- a. Provide updated data to Public Works and Community Planning staff on socioeconomic status and walkability, as called for by sidewalk project criteria.
- b. Meet with Community Planning and Public Works staff as necessary to review proposed changes to sidewalk project criteria.

4. TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT:

This agreement will be re-evaluated by all parties every four years. Any changes to this agreement will be re-negotiated between all signatory parties.
