IMPORTANT NOTE: Service providers must complete and submit Conflict of Interest Disclosure form at time of application.

Resident Homeowners:

Per Clark County Code 24.17.24.6:

- (6) Resident homeowners may provide their own OSS inspections (conventional gravity systems only)¹ and every other required operation and maintenance inspection if:
- (a) The system is located at their primary place of residence;
 - (b) They complete required CCPH testing prior to attempting to inspect their OSS;²
 - (c) For inspections:
 - (i) They provide a report of findings on a CCPH designated form;
 - (ii) The inspection is not a final inspection following installation or one that is used to meet the requirement of inspection at the time of sale or transfer;
 - (iii) An inspection is carried out by the resident homeowner no more than every six (6) years for conventional gravity systems (every other inspection to be done by a certified O&M specialist);
 - (iv) They comply with all other requirements of this chapter.

¹ Includes conventional gravity systems with or without pumps.

² Resident homeowners must attend the Clark County Public Health's Homeowner's Workshop class, pass the 6 question exam, and pay a fee of \$20.
