FREE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE (HHW) DISPOSAL!

Clark County residents may dispose of unwanted household hazardous waste products at one of the following county-sponsored HHW collection sites or events. Eligible senior and disabled citizens who are unable to transport HHW to a sponsored site may call (360) 397-6118 ext. 4352 to arrange for free pick up. Business-generated hazardous waste will not be accepted at these sites.

WHAT IS HAZARDOUS WASTE?

Household hazardous waste (HHW) products include pesticides, paints, solvents, batteries, thinners, motor oil, and antifreeze. Look for signal words such as poison, danger, warning, caution, or flammable on the label.

To dispose of your HHW products at a county-sponsored disposal site:

DO:

- Keep HHW products separate (do not mix).
- Bring products in their original containers when possible.
- Seal products to prevent leaks and spills.
- Keep products away from the driver and passengers, i.e., in a trunk, truck bed, or trailer.
- Keep children and pets away from collection sites and events.

DO NOT:

- Exceed 25 gallons or 220 pounds of HHW per event.
- Bring unlabeled, empty or leaking containers, asbestos, explosives or ammunition, radioactive or infectious waste, or business-generated waste to the collection site.
