A joint resolution of the Boards of County Commissioners for Klickitat, Clark and Skamania counties relating to the appointment of trustees to the Fort Vancouver Regional Library.

WHEREAS, in 1952, Clark County and Skamania County formed an Interrural Rural Library District; and

WHEREAS, in 1973, the Intercounty Rural Library District was expanded to include Klickitat County; and

WHEREAS, in 1981, the City of Vancouver annexed into the Intercounty Rural Library District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 27.12.130 and 27.12.190, the Boards of County Commissioners of the participating counties within the Intercounty Rural Library District are to appoint a board of trustees through joint action; and

WHEREAS, Klickitat, Clark and Skamania counties have entered into an Interlocal Agreement setting forth the process for the appointment of trustees; and

WHEREAS, the term for Position No. 6 which is held by Bonnie Reynolds representing Klickitat County will expire December 31, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Bonnie Reynolds has decline an invitation for reappointment to Position No. 6 as Klickitat County's designee for a seven year term; and

WHEREAS, Kate Maple of Klickitat, Washington has expressed a desire and has accepted an invitation for appointment to Position No. 6 representing Klickitat County; and



Board of County Commissioners:

I was delighted to be asked by Naomi Fisher, Goldendale Librarian, to consider a position on the Fort Vancouver Regional Library Board of Directors.

Since moving to Klickitat County in 2009 as an Americorps Volunteer in literacy with Head Start, I have been advocating for better library services in our rural community. I started by requesting a book return in our area and then educated citizens on the availability of books by mail through flyers, newsletters and the Klickitat Community Facebook page. I have personally seen how having access to library materials can change an entire rural community of people for the better.

~~I have been an active member of the Friends of the Goldendale Library since 2009 and have been using my marketing skills to create their bi-monthly newsletter and other materials since 2010. I have also recently brought the Friends into the 21st century with a Facebook Page, please like us! I believe Friends groups are the rural libraries best advocates with their ability to network and raise funds for library programs.~~

I have worked in many types of libraries since 1993 and have a diverse background. I started in public libraries back when technology was just being introduced and personally uploaded barcoded 30,000 titles when the Internet was accessed slowly via phone lines. From there it was on to a DOD School Library on an airbase in Japan, then to Alaska at a University where I earned my undergraduate degree and worked 10 years in interlibrary loan. After 10 years of the dark, and 20 below zero, I decided to return to the lower 48 which brought me to service work in the Gorge. I am currently employed at a non-profit which provides services to people with intellectual disabilities.

I also serve on other Boards in the Gorge area; the Klickitat CEKC group for the Klickitat Community, The Arc of the Mid-Columbia, Hood River Adopt-a-Dog and Oregon APSE (Association of People Supporting Employment First). I serve on various committees on the boards, mostly media and membership based. I spend much of my free time helping non-profits.

I have a BAS from the University of Alaska, Fairbanks and earned my graduate degree in Information Science from Drexel University. Besides my love of libraries, I also value education.

Thank you for your consideration of my application for this seven year appointment to the Board. I believe I will be a strong voice in advocating for library services in Klickitat County.
