BACKGROUND: This project will construct a pedestrian bridge on the north side of Pleasant Valley Community Park, providing access between the 14500 block of NE Salmon Creek Avenue and the 40 acre park.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH: A preliminary master plan for Pleasant Valley Community Park was developed in 2005 as part of the Greater Clark Parks District. Citizen involvement in the master plan development included two public meetings and multiple mailings.

BUDGET AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS: Funding for this project comes from park impact fees and real estate excise taxes dedicated to park development. This project is included in the County Parks Department's 2014 construction program.
