REQUEST: Approval of the attached Notice summarizing construction projects completed with county forces in calendar year 2013, and approval of the attached Notice of proposed county forces projects in calendar year 2014.

BACKGROUND: To be in compliance with RCW 36.77.070, Clark County must publish a notice listing projects that used county forces in the previous calendar year and the cost of those projects. The county must also publish a notice of intent to use county forces on upcoming projects in the current calendar year and the estimated cost of those projects. The use of county forces is limited to levels established by formula in RCW 36.77.065. Clark County is well below the authorized limit.


COMMUNITY OUTREACH: Outreach includes public comment and formal hearings on the Annual Construction Program and Transportation Improvement Plan. Staff also regularly receives suggestions from the public on locations for small sidewalk, guardrail and other projects often performed by county forces.

NOTICE

Pursuant to Revised Code of Washington Section 36.77.070, notice is hereby given that the Clark County Board of Commissioners has determined the following construction projects should be constructed by county forces during 2014. Specifically, this work involves:

Transportation Program

- Traffic Signal Optimization at various locations on Highway 99, Hazel Dell Ave, NW 78th St, NW 99th St, NE 72nd Ave, and St Johns Rd.
- Signal inspection and testing for capital projects including: NE 119th St @ Salmon Creek Ave, and NE 47th Ave @ NE 78th St.
- Incidental support of County Road Projects including NE 119th St @ NE 50th Ave, NE 99th St (Highway 99 to St. Johns Rd), and Highway 99 Interim Sidewalk (NE 99th St to Parkview Dr).

Sidewalk/ ADA Program

- Sidewalk construction and ADA ramp construction or replacement at various locations including NE 43rd Ave @ McCann Rd, NE 44th St (City Limits to NE 42nd Ave), NE 49th St (City Limits to NE 40th Ave), NE 110th St (Hazel Dell Ave to NE 5th Ave), NE 111th St (Hazel Dell Ave to NE 5th Ave), and NE 5th Ave (NE 110th St to NE 112th St).

Pavement Preservation Program

- Preservation Program: preparatory work, crack filling, signing, striping and placement of shoulder rock incidental to 2013 and 2014 overlays at various locations including NW Overlook Dr, NE 68th St, NW Seward Rd, NW 41st Ave, NE Andresen Rd, NW McCann Rd, NE Salmon Creek Ave, NE Ward Rd, NE Reilly Rd, SE 362nd Ave, NE 142nd Ave, NE Axford Rd, NE 182nd Ave, NE 88th St, NE 209th St, and NE Risto Rd.

The Clark County Engineer estimates the construction costs for these projects will be \$585,000.

Pursuant to Revised Code of Washington Section 36.77.070, notice is hereby given that the Clark County Board of Commissioners has overseen county forces construction projects for the calendar year of 2013 at the following locations:

Transportation Program

- Support of capital construction projects at various locations including: NE 119th St @ NE 50th Ave, NE 88th St (Highway 99 to St Johns Rd), NE 139th St (NE 10th Ave to NE 20th Ave), and NE 72nd Ave @ NE 119th St.
- Traffic Signal Optimization: Signal inspection and testing at various locations on NE 99th St, NE 78th St, Highway 99, Padden Parkway, Andresen Road and NE 88th St.
- Moorehaven Slide Stabilization: NW Bolen Rd to Jenny Creek Rd.
- Pavement Preservation Program: Signing, striping and other incidental work on capital projects at various locations including NE Hazel Dell Ave, NE 50th Ave, NE 95th St, NE 99th St, NE 101st St, and NE 102nd St.

Safety Program

- Safety Projects: Signing, striping, and intersection improvements at various locations including: NE 199th St @ NE 29th Ave, NW Lakeshore Ave @ NW 99th St, NE 20th Ave @ NE 144th St, Padden Pkwy @ NE 94th Ave, Highway 99 @ NE Parkview Dr, and NW 36th Ave @ McCann Rd.
- Guardrail Improvements at various locations including: Highway 99 near NE Parkview Dr, NE 159th Street/Railroad Crossing, and NW 199th St/Delfel Rd.

Sidewalk/ADA Program

- Sidewalk Program: construction of sidewalk and ADA ramps on NE 29th Ave (NE 148th St to NE 150th St), NE 43rd Ave at McCann Rd, NE 50th Ave (NE 99th St to NE 102nd St), NE 95th St (NE 91st Ave to NE 93rd Ave), NE 104th St (NE 23rd Ave to NE 26th Pl), and Hazel Dell Ave (Alki Rd to NE 63rd St).

The total cost for county forces projects for the 2013 calendar year was **\$160,820.57**.
