REQUEST: Consider an amendment to the Clark County policy regarding business expense reimbursements for certain county elected officials.

**BACKGROUND:** In 2012 the Board of County Commissioners did not increase the vehicle allowance for Positions 1, 2 and Position 3.

**COMMUNITY OUTREACH:** On October 28, 2014 the Board of County Commissioners will consider and hear public comment on a staff report that would extend vehicle allowance increases to become effective January 1, 2015 through January 1, 2020 for Positions 1 and 2 and through January 1, 2018 for Position 3.

**BUDGET AND POLICY IMPLICATIONS:** Amending the car allowance increase will have a \$4,800 impact for the 2015-2016 biennium.
