

# CLARK COUNTY VETERANS ADVISORY BOARD

## 2015-2016 LETTER OF INTENT ORGANIZATION

Membership eligibility shall be provided to each nationally recognized Veterans' organization or veterans from the community at large that have registered with the County under Washington State RCW 73.08.010. Veterans at large shall submit a letter of appointment and provide proof of service in the Armed Forces. Service organizations and Veterans at large may be given full membership by majority vote of the Resource Committee. No less than a majority of the board members shall be members from nationally recognized veterans' service organizations and only veterans are eligible to serve as board members.

Each organization may appoint one (1) alternate member. Alternate members who are appointed in accordance with Sections 2.1 and 2.3 shall be able to vote on issues only in the absence of the Primary Member of the organization or agency they are representing.
